

Professor Steven Percival holds a PhD in biofilms, a BSc in Applied Biological Sciences, Postgraduate Certificate in Education, diploma in Business Administration, and master degrees in Public Health, Medical and Molecular Microbiology. Early in his career, Steven held R&D, operations and commercial positions at Phenomenex Ltd, The British Textile Technology Group Ltd, followed then by 6 years as a senior university lecturer in medical microbiology and later the positions of Director of R&D and Chief Scientific Officer at Aseptica, Inc. He also held senior clinical microbiology fellowships at the Centers for Disease Control, Atlanta, and The Leeds Teaching Hospitals Trust, Leeds, UK. More recently, Steven held senior R&D positions at Bristol Myers Squibb, ConvaTec, Advanced Medical Solutions Plc and an honorary professorship at West Virginia University. In 2011, Steven joined Scapa Healthcare as Vice President of Global R&D, Healthcare and was awarded the position of honorary Professor in the Institute of Ageing and Chronic Disease and Surface Science Research Centre at The University of Liverpool, UK. Steven has written over 320 scientific publications and conference abstracts on biofilms, antimicrobials, wounds and infection control, authored and edited seven textbooks and provided over 120 international presentations. He is also recognized globally as a key opinion leader (KOL) on biofilms, antimicrobials and wound microbiology.
